Through Him, With Him and In Him

Like many parents my wife and I encourage our children to be more concerned in life with effort than results. We reflect with them how results are often subjective and arbitrary, whereas effort is measurable and controlable. Either you put the time in or you do not and in the end if you work hard, success naturally follows.

A quote I recently read by St. Francis Xavier is causing me to rethink this theory. The quote says that: "It is not the actual physical exertion that counts toward a person's progress, nor the nature of the task, but the spirit with which it is undertaken." I find this quote fascinating.

Instead of using effort or results as a measure of success it instead focuses on the spirit with which the task in undertaken. This makes perfect sense as if the spirit with which we undertake something is not for the glory of God it is of no value regardless how much success is attained. In fact, any success attained if it is not attributed to God given talents and grace can lead to pride which is the polar opposite of success and the most dangerous of all sins.

Success from a spiritual and worldly perspective looks very different. From the worldly perspective, success consists of achievements, wealth, and power whereas success from a spiritual perspecitive consists of mystical union with our divine Creator and neighbour as One Body in Christ.

As Christians, it is often a challenge to balance our internal desires for both worldly and spiritual success. We are of the world and to cut ourselves completely off from pursuing worldly success would be extremely difficult but, in the end, it is always important to keep in mind that only spiritual success really matters.

No matter how much worldly success we have, it doesn't matter to the God who created us. God's invites us to live our lives through, with and in the Holy Spirit as opposed to doing things 'Our way' as Sinatra once sang in imitation of Adam and Eye.

It isn't easy to approach the tasks in our lives through the lens of the Holy Spirit and this is why Matthew encourages us to: 'Enter through the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the road is easy that leads to destruction, and there are many who take it. For the gate is narrow and the road is hard that leads to life, and there are few who find it.'

Each morning then let us wake and ask God to pour out his Holy Spirit upon us that we may approach each task of our day in union together. Not worrying too much about what we are doing or how well we are doing but instead living as suggested by Hildegarde of Bingen as 'a feather on the breath of God.'

Lay Carmelites are Roman Catholic men and women called to seek God's will in the ordinary circumstances of everyday life. They


