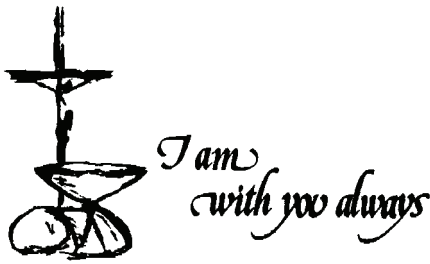

**COME, FOLLOW ME. HOW BEING A DISCIPLE IS NOT WHAT YOU THINK**

The privatization of religion refers to keeping your religious beliefs in the confines of your mind, home, or worship space. Public expression of religious belief ought to be minimized or avoided all together.

**Why Our Society Doesn't Get Religion**

A side affect of accepting this view is that religious belief is relegated to the level of personal hobbies. For example, I play tennis, I enjoy reading, and I am Catholic on Sundays. Tennis and reading are not lenses through which I view the world, but my Catholic faith is. No belief system is a hobby, whether it is religious or materialist in nature. Belief systems define our realities.

**It Takes Courage to Be a Disciple**

So what does this have to do with discipleship?

In today's Gospel Jesus calls four disciples. Their response to Jesus is worth noting. Jesus calls Simon (later named Peter) and Andrew as they are fishing. Simon and Andrew "immediately left their nets and followed him" (Mk 1:19). Next, Jesus calls James and his John who responded by leaving their father and servants behind to follow Jesus (cf. V.20).

Notice how the four disciples immediately leave their comfort zones behind to follow Jesus. Simon and Andrew's identities shift from being fishermen to disciples of Jesus. Similarly, James and John's identity shift from their social status to disciples. It is likely James and John came from a wealthy family because they had "hired servants" (see v.20).

Now to be clear, it is highly unlikely that the disciples completely abandoned their jobs since they needed to fund Jesus' ministry and, in the case of Peter, was responsible for the care of his mother-in-law (cf. Lk 4:38-40). The emphasis is on the disciples' identity shifting from fishermen and sons of a wealthy father to being followers of Jesus. They are no longer limited to seeing the world through their job or social status, but their view of reality has expanded through the lens of Jesus Christ.

In complete contrast to Jonah in the first reading, the response made by Andrew and Simon Peter in the gospel to the call 'Follow me and I will make you fishers of men' was instantaneous. Without any hesitation and with no idea of the consequence, this identical response was made by James and John, another pair of brothers. All four were fishermen and following Jesus meant abandoning the life they knew and embarking into an unknown future. We don't know if they knew a lot about Jesus before his invitation, but their decision was courageous and generous. His call must of stirred up something deep in their hearts, as they were the first of millions of people to respond to his invitation to follow him. They set out on a journey that would change them beyond imagining and give them a new found freedom to leave old ways behind and walk a better path.
