Christ's invitation to Zacchaeus to "come down, hurry because I must stay at your house today" is addressed to everyone who is not happy with their situation. This is an opportunity to open our hearts and place before God our fears, worries, uncertainties and to ask for the richness of his healing presence in the midst of our concerns. Jesus is always out meeting people, befriending them where they are and offering them a love that has the power to change their lives. It is a love that involves continuous conversion and a change of behaviour on our part. Knowing that God accepts us unconditionally should lead us to respond generously too. We have a future and should not feel held back by our sinful past.

The Voices in Our Head

A man convicted of numerous crimes was asked why he committed them. He said he did not plan to but a voice in his head kept encouraging him. Upon later reflection he realized that the voice was not his own.

The same is true of a woman who attempted suicide on numerous occasions. When asked why, she told a psychiatrist that a voice in her head kept saying that 'I hate you' and that I should just end it all. When asked how it is possible for the 'I' to hate the 'self' she realized that it was a metaphysical impossibility so there must have been another power at play.

A few years ago a friend who lost a loved one and was so distraught that she thought she could not carry on. Then one day a voice in her head told her: you are mine and everything will be ok. The voice brought her great consolation.

Like these examples we all have voices in our head that speak to us, sometimes they work for us, and sometimes they work against us in the forms of positive and negative self-talk. The key to having them work for us is in discerning which voice is speaking. Author Wendy Nelson suggests that we can tell which voice it is by the agenda it supports. The Enemy's agenda is rejection and distress whereas the Ally's agenda is peace and wholeness so if what the voice is saying leads us to despair we should ignore it and instead listen for the voice that affirms us. Ignatius of Loyola describes such feelings as desolation and consolation and encourages us to note the behavior connected with the feeling and repeat the behavior that results in consolation.

It is upsetting to think that the Enemy is able to use our voice to manipulate us but it makes sense. For if we thought it was actually the devil speaking then we would never listen, but our own voice we happily follow. St. Mark warns of this when he says, "whatever goes into a person from outside cannot defile, but what comes out of a person that defiles. ²¹For it is from within, from the human heart, that evil intentions come." The key therefore is to refuse the devil permission to steal our voice.

This weekend in the Gospel, we encounter Zacchaeus who learns to discern the voices in his head as he recognizes Jesus' voice calling him to communion and generosity and rejects the Enemy's voice of greed and corruption. May we also learn to discern the voice of Jesus calling us by name and leading us by still waters.
