UNITED NATIONS INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR THE ELIMINATION OF VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN

"Not until the half of our population represented by women and girls can live free from fear, violence and everyday insecurity, can we truly say we live in a fair and equal world." (UN Secretary-General António Guterres)

November 25th is the day designated by United Nations for the Elimination of Violence Against Women. This issue includes human trafficking, missing and murdered indigenous women and girls, and domestic abuse.

Violence against women is not just a women's issue. It's an issue for all of us and all faith communities. When violence is used to dominate or hurt another person – this goes against everything Jesus taught us.

Because abuse often occurs out of sight, it is assumed that it does not happen. We have to see the hidden face of domestic violence. Domestic violence is a behavior pattern based on the use of power and control of one person over another

There are different forms of abuse. The term "violence" may apply equally to physical force or hidden violence that does not necessarily do physical harm but nevertheless destroys human dignity – such as emotional violence, verbal violence that isolates a person from family and friends, or economic violence – financial control.

Violence against women thrives on silence. Naming injustice is the first step to freedom from violence not only for the abused but also for the abuser. Abusers will not change until they realize and name their actions as wrong – simply wrong with no excuses.

Our church teaches forgiveness but forgiveness does not mean allowing things to go on as before. Yes, forgiveness is a goal but it is a goal to be freely pursued from a position of safety.
