Receiving God's Gifts

In life the saying goes: 'It is better to give than to receive' but that is not the case in the spiritual life. In the spiritual life and especially during Advent it is all about receiving but we do have to give something and that is our attention.

This is the message that I gave to the children who celebrated their First Reconciliation Saturday morning. For many of the children it was their first sacramental encounter that they are conscious of, being baptized as babies so I encouraged them not to miss Jesus coming in the sacrament because it is so easy to be caught up with protocol, with remembering the opening: 'Bless me Father for I have sinned this is my first reconciliation and these are my sins' and the sins themselves. We all face similar challenges each Advent as we can easily miss the coming of Jesus as we get caught up with the protocol of the season.

One of the blessings of Advent and Christmas is that we get a chance to spend time with family and the people who are closest to us so it is important to embrace the opportunity. A friend of mine was sharing what he found remarkable about the Sister's of Life and that was when you are in their presence you feel that you have their undivided attention which speaks to our inherent dignity and divine value.

I tried this the other night with my middle son as he was whittling away on his homework. Normally I would be checking emails or sport scores as he scribbles down his answers but this time, I simply beheld his beauty. What a gift it was and as he finished writing his answer, he looked up at me and could tell that I was beholding something so he blushed and gave me a big hug and kiss. It was a wonderful and intimate experience between the two of us, who thought that homework could be so fulfilling.

This same inherent beauty we see in others, also proceeds from ourselves so it is helpful to be aware of this as we interact with others. When we can step back into a metacognitive position and see ourselves as divine gift to others, it helps us to see how beautiful we are and to reconcile with ourselves. It also helps us to appreciate how God is utilizing our gifts.

This advent then let us begin opening our gifts early as we fully receive all who come into our lives for each are filled with divine light and beauty. Let us make straight their paths into our hearts as we join Elizabeth saying:

'Blessed are you and blessed is the fruit of thy womb Jesus,'
