

Pope Francis' Easter Message

In his Easter Vigil homily, Pope Francis likened the experience of the women in Jerusalem to that of people around the world today as they endure the COVID 19 pandemic. "They, like us, had before their eyes the drama of suffering, of an unexpected tragedy that happened all too suddenly...pain was mixed with fear, would they suffer the same fate as the Master. Then too there was a fear about the future and all that would need to be rebuilt. For them, as for us, it was the darkest hour."

"Yet in this situation the women did not allow themselves to be paralyzed. They hear Jesus' words. "do not be afraid" do not yield to fear. This is the message of hope. These are the words that God repeats to us today."

"Tonight we acquire a fundamental right – the right to hope. It is a new and living hope that comes from God. It is not mere optimism...it is a gift from heaven....Jesus plants in our hearts the conviction that God is able to make everything work unto good, because even from the grave he brings life.

In his Urbi et Orbi on Easter Sunday, Pope Francis challenges us to ban indifference, self-centredness, division during this time— to spread the "contagion of hope" - one that is transmitted — "from heart to heart......Christ's resurrection is not a magic formula that makes problems vanish... it is the victory of love over the root of evil. This victory does not by-pass suffering and death, but passes through them transforming evil into good."

In his Easter Sunday Letter to members of social movements around the world Pope Francis, noting that the financial suffering caused by COVID 19 suggested that this crisis warrented the establishment of a basic universal income. "This may be the time to consider a universal basic wage which would acknowledge and dignify that are carried out... It would ensure and concretely achieve the ideal, at once so human and so Christian, of no workers without rights." The Pope suggested that a reordering of priorities in the aftermath of should lead to "universal access to work, housing and land and food as fundamental to justly-ordered societies."

Pope Francis urges people today "to cling to the Risen Jesus... to be pilgrims in search of hope....to turn our backs on death and open our hearts to Jesus..for Jesus is life itself".

Let us take the words of Pope Francis to heart and live them with our lives.




