Ecumenical Sunday

Brothers and Sisters, it goes without saying that this past 2 years in our lives, and indeed the entire world has been something we've never seen before. Of course, I'm speaking of the global pandemic, not that humanity has never experienced a pandemic, but I don't believe there has ever been a pandemic in a world that is so "connected". This is a moment in history where we're all united by one challenge. Even though our experience, perspectives, response and opinions are different, COVID-19 has impacted every person in the world today.

Reflecting on this and the readings from this weekend, I'm reminded that even though, in our faith, we have different experiences, talents, perspectives, and opinions about God and His Church, we are all called to be united and are baptized into one body of Christ. "For in the one Spirit we were all baptized into one body...and we were all made to drink of one Spirit" (1Cor 12: 13).

Some people are born to write, others to speak, others to counsel. People are born with great intelligence, amazing athleticism, or incredible artistic ability. Each of us has our own gifts, as St. Paul attests to, and those gifts come from God.

Scripture is a gift from God. God's Law, seen in the first reading, is a gift. Preachers and pastors who teach and translate God's law are gifts to His Church, though not always appreciated for it. Those who "know" the Lord in His Word and in His Sacrament ought to have a humble boldness, a quiet confidence, and an unshakable joy, even in the face of adversity. As revealed in the Gospel, the Word of the Lord points us to the eternal Word – Jesus, Himself. Additionally, God's Word reminds us that if we fail to follow God in our hearts, our words mean little. How we live, what we say and don't say, do and don't do, ought to be a living testament to the God who gave us our blessings and skills and our very lives as a testament of His goodness. When people meet us, there should be no doubt that there is a God and we are not Him.

On this Ecumenical Sunday, I pray and hope in God, that we might allow Him to live through us, with us, and in us, so that during this global pandemic we might look to Him to unite us all in His glory, but above all, that His will be done.

<u>Challenge:</u> During the week, write out your hopes and plans, and then offer them to God. We should pray about our desires and our hopes daily, but always conclude with, "Lord, may your will be done." Seek the will of God daily, even above your own will.
