Each year on Palm Sunday, we read an account of the Passion of Jesus. As we listen to it, we are reminded of the cowardice of the followers who abandoned him in his greatest hour of need, of the wickedness of the religious leaders who plotted his death, and of the cruelty of the soldiers who carried out his execution. We are reminded of these things because we have a kinship with them, but that is not the purpose of the Passion reading.

The emphasis is on Jesus. What we are remembering is the fidelity, the courage, and the sheer goodness of Jesus. Against the darkness of the Calvary, his goodness shines even more brightly. The day of his death is not called "Bad Friday" but "Good Friday". What makes it good is the love of Jesus, "Greater love no man has than to lay down his life for his friends." It is that love that we remember this week. It is the triumph of good over evil, of love over hate, of light over darkness and of life over death.

We Are Not Alone

One of the great challenges of our times is loneliness. Loneliness can be experienced by people of all ages but especially vulnerable are the youth and the elderly. It has become such a problem that some countries like Japan and the United Kingdom are now appointing ministers of lonliness.

One of the great strengths of our Christian faith is the assurance that we are never completely alone. It's one of the many extraordinary and unique aspects of Christianity which we can take for granted and not really reflect upon.

Most religions propose a transcendent God – one to whom we must reach out to, rise up to. But in a revolutionary way, Christianity turns this schema on its head. Without losing his transcendence, our God took the initiative. As with the father of the prodigal son, he saw us from afar and came down to meet us where we are - part of the so-called "scandal" of which St Paul speaks – and now he makes his home in the very depths of our being, the temple of the Holy Spirit, as the Apostle mentions to the Corinthians.

What an extraordinary concept, at once comforting and fearful. If you really think about it, consider that in baptism, we conceive the Blessed Trinity in our being. It is our personal annunciation. And similar to the Blessed Virgin Mary, we bear the Divinity wherever we go. As St Augustine put it so beautifully, we have the assurance that Christ is "closer to us than we are to ourselves."

So when we experience periods of isolation and loneliness it is important to consciously tap into the indwelling of God in our souls. As the Gospel of John underscores, he dwells in us, and we in him. But unlike sensible things, like hunger and pain, we're not usually conscious of the divinity within. Therefore, we need to find a way of "practicing the presence of God", as it is called. There are a great number of ways to do this but the simplest is to acknowledge God's presence throughout the day with short prayers of welcome, praise and thanksgiving and to celebrate the sacraments as frequently as possible.

Regardless there will be times in our life when we feel sure God has let us down, that he is far away, that we are completely alone. As in the desert, the Tempter will whisper that God has abandoned us. In these moments, it is helpful to recall a time when we felt filled with Christ's presence and to remember that same God continues to dwell within and has not gone anywhere.

God's perceived absence can also be a sign of a maturing faith and an opportunity to love God as God has always loved us, unconditionally and to take on the yoke of Christ. John Humphries.
