The Ascension of the Lord

Jesus ascends into heaven. The disciples stare blankly into the sky. What in the world just happened? And what in the world does this mean?

The beauty of Ascension Sunday lies in the details. First, Jesus ascended to heaven with His glorified body. This means that Christ bore the marks of Crucifixion as He took His place on the throne of heaven. The writer of the letter to the Hebrews explains that this detail is critical – we have a God that understands our suffering who we can humbly approach with our needs. Our God understands and invites us, invites you, personally into this throne room and sanctuary. Jesus' bodily ascension opens the door for our bodily resurrection at the end of time.

The second important detail is that Jesus will return with His glorified body in judgment. As the apostles stare at the sky like they just saw a double rainbow, an angel tells them that time is limited. They shouldn't "just stand there" – they have work to do in spreading the Gospel before Jesus comes again! Many will be called, in fact, to be martyrs (the Greek word for "witnesses"). We can only embrace martyrdom if we look heavenward. We also have work to do in inviting others to know the God that understands our sufferings and invites us into the throne room of heaven. Not some distant, far off god that looks down on us from the clouds; nor the "universe" or some strange obscure spirit. We invite others to know a personal God that made us for an intimate relationship with Himself, a God that "loved" us into existence to love (willing the good of the other for the other). So, don't just stand around, there's work to do this week in proclaiming the risen Lord!

God is calling you! How will you respond?

Reflect:

How are you being called today to be His witness? Whom are you called to share your experiences of Christ with?

Challenge:

This week, reflect on what it means to be "absolutely trusting" of God. Do you need more trust that He does understand how you are feeling when you are angry or upset? Do you need more trust that everything is in His control? Do you need more trust that He won't lead you somewhere He can't protect you?

What do you need from God in order to grow in this absolute trust of Him? Ask yourself first, and then make your requests known to God.


