“The Lord comes to rule the earth with justice.”

By now, you are probably sensing a common theme in the readings and it isn’t butterflies and flying unicorns. The imagery that the prophet Malachi uses is frightening, well, at least if you’re an “evil doer.” If evil is your game, the forecast is going to get very hot. Malachi’s prophecies come at a time that was filled with a lot of corruption at various levels of political and religious power and his prophecy strikes at the heart of this corruption. His message is simple, “God sees, and it won’t last. Someone is coming to make things right again.”

In a similar way, Paul calls out the people in Thessalonica for their laziness and refusal to work yet thrives on the work of others. He was likely speaking to those in power that benefitted from the labour of others yet did nothing to help. Laziness is a form of corruption, and Paul doesn’t want any of it. Rather, he wants people to work and avoid laziness. Why be ready? Because just as Malachi prophesied the first coming of Christ, St. Paul wants people to be ready for the second. In the Gospel, Jesus points to His second coming and the trials that will precede it. There will be persecution, but for those that avoid the path of corruption the ending is clear: Jesus wins this victory. As we approach the season of Advent, the readings remind us that we need to always be prepared for the second coming of Christ, working diligently to share our faith and if necessary defend it – knowing that at any moment Jesus could return to set the world on fire.

Do something out of the ordinary for your prayer routine. Make it something that is challenging for you (but something you can accomplish). Keep a journal about your prayer experiences every day, noting how easy or challenging the prayer you’ve chosen feels.

Challenge of the Month:

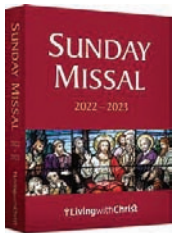
