Presentation of the Lord

This week there is much to celebrate; it is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, Candlemas, the 40th day after the Lord's birth, the 4th Joyful Mystery of the rosary, and not to mention it's also Groundhog Day.

The Message: God has a plan for us, for me, and for you; He is always present, loving us in every moment in our lives, in my life and in your life. Even in moments of suffering and unexplainable times of despair, and yes, even in those moments in our lives when, from our perspective, we only see injustice, there exists love; for God is love and love is God.

In Depth: In the first reading from the prophet Malachi 3:1 he writes, "I am sending my messenger to prepare the way before me"; which was written over 400 years before Jesus. Later, in Luke 2: 26-35, "It had been revealed" to Simeon, a pious elder, "by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Messiah". Simeon took Jesus, "praised God" and "said to his mother Mary, 'This child is destined for the falling and the raising of many in Israel, and to be a sign that will be opposed...and a sword will pierce your own soul too." These prophases and scripture passages demonstrate God's perspective and that God has a plan; and still has a plan for us.

The second thing to note is the contradiction of this 4th Joyful Mystery of the Rosary, what St. John Paul II writes in Redemptoris Mater, is Mary's second Annunciation, that "a sword will pierce your own soul too". How is this message Joyful? This tells Mary "of the actual historical situation in which the Son is to accomplish his mission, namely in misunderstanding and sorrow. While this announcement on the one hand confirms her faith in the accomplishment of the divine promises of salvation, on the other hand it also reveals to her that she will have to live her obedience of faith in suffering, at the side of the suffering Saviour, and that her motherhood will be mysterious and sorrowful." Like so much of our Catholic faith, we are called by God to love our enemies; to love as He did, in what appears to be a contradiction; "that through death he might destroy the one who has the power of death. Therefore he had to become like his brothers and sisters in every respect, because he himself was tested by what he suffered, he is able to help those who are being tested." (Heb 2:14-18)

So, whether we are in a time of joy or sorrow, remember that God has a plan for us and that he proved "his love for us in that while we still were sinners Christ died for us." (Rom 5: 8)


