He wants us to develop strength of character in order to forgive and refrain from hitting back and levelling the score. There is ample evidence around us of the devastating effects of life lived according to the rule of an eye for an eye. Just think of the energy we waste holding on to past hurts, trying to settle old scores, or handing down grudges from one generation to the next. Hatred does not add to our stature but tears us apart, because once we retaliate and start hating our enemies we give them power over us, which can turn our days and nights into turmoil. However, when we let go of the hatred within our hearts, we do things differently. We develop a kind tongue, a soft touch that enables us to overlook faults, refuse to pass judgement and discover the good qualities in people.
