

Harden Not Your Hearts

I have a friend who is estranged from his family. At one point there was a disagreement and after that he told me that he was closing the door on them. His mother is finding the rupture extremely difficult. She has tried many times to reconcile and at one point even went to his house and stood outside the door knocking but no one answered.

This weekend in the Gospel, we once again encounter Thomas who despite his doubts never turns his back on Jesus. Jesus is preparing the disciples for his impending Passion and like the other disciples, Jesus' words confuse Thomas. Thomas is unafraid to share his confusion and says to Jesus: 'Lord, we do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?"

The truth is that doubts are completely natural in life and relationships. We all have doubts and they are the seeds of our faith. We have doubts and over time as we experience the consistent love of a family member, a spouse or a friend we grow in faith and trust. The same is true of our relationship with God. It is completely natural to have our doubts about a God we can neither see nor touch. The important thing is what we do with our doubts. Do they distance us from God or do we bring them to God and allow God to reveal himself through them.

Many people think the opposite of faith is doubt but this is not true. The opposite of faith is hardness of heart and is a completely different thing. Hardness of heart is when we turn our backs on a person or God and cut ourselves off from them. When we close the door on a relationship and consider the relationship dead as we see Judas do following his betrayal of Jesus.

Most of us have likely tried this. We have been upset with someone and decide to cut ourselves off from them, we stop being a window of God's love to them. When we see them at home or in public, we refuse to acknowledge them.

When we do this if feels like we are literally dying but we continue because we feel we need to teach them a lesson. Eventually by the grace of God, we hopefully come to our senses and realize we need to swallow our pride and apologize. We are so blessed we have access to the healing grace of God that enables us to do so.

I continue to pray for my friend and his family and I hope he will eventually soften his heart towards them. I pray that somehow, he will hear Jesus' words, "Forgive them Father for they know not what they do." It gives us great hope that Jesus suffered to the greatest extent possible the collective rejection of humanity yet never hardened his heart towards us. Let us always pray for hearts like Jesus'.
