The oil that runs out, causing the spark of faith within us to dim, points to our neglect of good works that in the course of our lifetime we should have performed and which we cannot borrow or make good at this very late hour. We cannot recapture the past or nor go back in time to accomplish something we never started. Jesus was using his popular story to covey a serious message about the end of time. He was stressing the vital importance of being ready and prepared to meet the Lord and not to take entry into his kingdom for granted.

FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT

With Hallowe'en just behind us there are still lots of treats around our house, it's almost as if the kids have tucked some candy in each corner. Throughout the day, I discover and eat a chocolate here, a bag of chips there, without being consciously aware of it, half-asleep you might say. Before I know it is lunchtime and when my wife asks me if I would like a sandwich, I have to sheepishly tell her I'm already full on the kids' candy.

The same can be true of our spiritual life. We move from thing to thing, a little Facebook here, some YouTube there without really being conscious of it, half asleep. Finally, when we attempt to do something prayerful, we are easily distracted or fall asleep, filled with spiritual candy. Jesus warns us of such behaviour in the Gospel this weekend and encourages his disciples and us to keep our spiritual flasks filled with the oil of his Holy Spirit.

The degree to which we will recognize Christ moving amongst us will depend upon the degree we receive him into our lives. The more we allow his Spirit to pour into our hearts the more respondent we will be. This is illustrated by a famous preacher D.L. Moody who was speaking to a large audience and held up a glass and asking, "How can I get the air out of this glass?" One man shouted, "Suck it out with a pump!" Moody replied, "That would create a vacuum and shatter the glass." After numerous other suggestions Moody smiled, picked up a pitcher of water, and filled the glass.

Our spiritual life is much the same. We don't become holy by trying to be good and perfect, by picking out our imperfections like air from a glass as the world encourages and somehow thinks is possible. Rather we fill ourselves with the Spirit of God so there is no room left for any impurities.

This truth is grasped by 12 Step programs where the first 3 steps involve admitting how powerless we are over our addictions and turning to a Power greater than ourselves to fill and restore us to sanity.

Through the coming weeks as we come to the end of the liturgical year let's reflect on how we can incorporate more spiritually nutritious foods into our diets. Can we attend Mass and Confession more frequently? Can we make time for scripture, Rosary or a course like Alpha? Do we fast and practice almsgiving on a regular basis?

As CS Lewis describes only filled with God's Spirit can we be truly happy: "God designed the human machine to run on Himself. He Himself is the fuel our spirits were designed to burn, or the food our spirits were designed to feed on. There is no other. God cannot give us a happiness and peace apart from himself because it is not here." So let's continue to focus on filling our souls with the highest octane fuel there is, the Holy Spirit.


WHEELCHAIR SUNDAY


