Second Sunday of Advent: Baptism and Repentance

We can begin this reflection by reflecting on what the sacrament of baptism is, in essence. Often we describe it as that grace by which our sins are taken away, become a member of the Church, or perhaps gain eternal life. All of these descriptions, and some others, are of course true. However, these expressions are consequences or effects of baptism, rather than essential to it. Baptism, fundamentally, is the grace by which we die and are resurrected, not hyperbolically, but ontologically. There is a real death and rebirth that occurs, whereby we are given new and eternal life, forgiven of all our sins, and become members of the visible Church. For a further reflection and explanation, Brant Pitre (a prominent Catholic theologian and scholar) has a couple of videos on YouTube that are a good resource (simply type "Brant Pitre baptism" in the search bar). Our Gospel reading today brings into remembrance our call to this first sacrament of initiation and highlights its importance. Last week, our Gospel reading reminded us of the importance of vigilance and perseverance in the Lord. Let us reflect on the haste with which we are called to be baptized in St. John the Baptist's prophecies, and ponder how baptism is the beginning of the fulfillment of that promise, made by Christ, of salvation, and thus, its immeasurable importance.


