#### Prepare to Be Dazzled

Bart Simpson has a catchphrase he frequently uses on the TV show: 'Prepare to be dazzled.' It's a phrase we could use as we move from the feast of the Epiphany last week to the start of Jesus public ministry this week.

It is an exciting time with a new liturgical year joining Andrew and a fellow disciple as they encounter the most amazing person who ever lived for the first time. We can only imagine how they felt in Jesus' presence. They were prepared for this moment by John the Baptist who points to Jesus saying: "Look, here is the Lamb of God."

The two disciples trust John's acknowledgement and decide to follow Jesus. When Jesus turns and sees them following he says to them: 'What are you looking for?' They reply: 'Rabbi where are you staying?' Jesus says: 'Come and see.' So they came and saw.

Jesus presents the same question to each of us: "What are you looking for?" Do we respond with the familiar lyrics of a U2 song: "I still haven't found what I am looking for" or do we respond with Mary Magdelene: "I have seen the Lord." The key for the first 2 disciples and for us is taking the time to see or abide with Jesus. Experience is of little value until it is reflected upon. Until we take the time to fully see Jesus active in our lives our faith has little chance of growing for the old adage holds true, seeing is believing.

Once we develop a prayer life, it is truly dazzling for we see more and more how God is with us in every encounter and interaction. It is one of my greatest joys witnessing God's response to my petitions and prayers. As Paul aptly summarizes: "I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me."

The more we witness God's masterpiece unveiling in our lives the more trusting we will become and consequently the stronger our faith. Our prayer life will become less intercessory and more contemplative, uniting our will with God's and as St. Andre Bassett suggests: "Instead of trying to avoid hardships, we can ask God for the grace to bear them well."

It's not that we should stop sharing our hopes, fears and intentions with God as these are all essential parts of an intimate relationship and voicing our petitions with God is self revelatory in and of itself, but in voicing our concerns we hold an appreciation that God's ways aren't our ways and God's thoughts aren't our thoughts. So let's humbly approach the altar this weekend with eyes opened wide and prepare to be dazzled.

#### **Indigenous Reconciliation Fund Update**

On December 12, 2023, the Archdiocese of Toronto announced the first phase of funding as part of our \$6 million commitment to the Indigenous Reconciliation Fund (IRF). Through the tremendous generosity of parishioners throughout the archdiocese, including our own parish, more than \$2.7 million has been directed through the IRF to organizations and projects committed to promoting healing and reconciliation for communities and families.

Recipients include: **Embrace Life Council** located in Iqaluit, Nunavut who will receive \$250,000 over five years. The funds will be used for grief care packages to assist those mourning the loss of a loved one by suicide; **Native Peoples' Mission** located in Toronto, Ontario will receive \$150,000 over five years to expand programs and outreach of the mission and **Indigenous Spirit Fund**, a branch of Native Child and Family services of Toronto will receive \$400,000 over four years to enrich their *On the Land* culture camp program curriculum. This is in addition to \$100,000 from Catholic charities earlier this year via its ShareLife allocation.


