

We may enjoy more prosperity than any previous generation, yet our sense of emptiness increases as our reliance on material possessions blocks out spiritual values. Almost without knowing it, we stray off course, acquire sinful habits and lose our moral direction. To repent involves a willingness to change, to turn away from everything that chokes us off from things spiritual. Repentance enables us to become more dependent on Jesus who is the way, the truth and the life. This Lenten period is a time to turn to God with our whole heart and focus on the values and attitudes that help us live as Jesus would have us live. It is a season of grace when the church invites to leave ourselves free to be loved once more by God who cares for us totally.

Lent is about a Person

An excerpt from 'The Ascension Lenten Companion: Waling with Jesus to Jerusalem:

In the first paragraph of his first encyclical, Pope Benedict XVI writes, "Being Christian is not the result of an ethical choice or a lofty idea, but the encounter with an event, *a person*, which **gives life a new horizon and a decisive direction.**" The piercing simplicity of these words is deeply moving.

Being Christian is not about me. Being Christian is not about my choice for God. Being Christian cannot be defined by rules or rituals, nor can it be summed up in policies or piety. Of course, all these things are a part of the "holy order" of Catholicism. But being Christian is essentially about a person – and his name is Jesus.

Christianity is about *Jesus*, a *person*. It has been this way from the beginning. When Jesus called his disciples, his invitation was "*Follow me*" (Matthew 4:19; Luke 5:27); John 1:43). When he taught them the truth, he explicitly said, "*I* am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but by *me*" (John 14:6). No other religious leader in history has intentionally placed the focus on himself. However, Jesus continually places himself at the center of faith.

When we encounter this person, our lives change. For each of us, an "encounter with an even, *a person*," gives life "a new horizon and decisive direction."

If Christianity is about a person, that means Lent is also about a person. Lent is not simply about prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

Those disciplines help us focus on what we need to focus on: namely, *a person*. Lent is about a person. Lent is about Jesus.

I invite you today, and over the next forty days on a journey to spend your life with *a person*. Eat with him, walk with him, and laugh with him. Listen to his words of mercy and witness sinners' hearts transformed. See him push boundaries and expand your understanding of love. Feel the liberation of those who were bound and taste the shock of the religious authorities. Come to love this person, Jesus, who will ultimately be betrayed, imprisoned, tortured, and crucified.

This is your invitation. This is your Lent, an encounter with a *person* who gives life "a new horizon and a decisive direction."
