The human ego is again at work in the Gospel story as the disciples of Jesus argue over which one of them is the greatest. They have proven by these actions that they have merely been along for the ride. They have not understood what He has taught or what He is about and were certainly clueless about the meaning of His impending passion and death. His response to them must have been both puzzling and shocking: the greatest is the one who is last and the servant of all. It goes against so much of what makes up the human personality: competition, dominance, recognition and self-promotion.

Deflating the hungry ego is hard work, but something to which we should pay a lot more attention. If we do not, then even the good we do becomes contaminated with self-seeking and selfish desire. The spirituality that Jesus imparted to His followers was intended to bring about a profound interior change. True disciples are those who govern their lives by the law of **love** and who strive to be men and women for others.

What did Jesus mean when?

"Sometimes we are incredibly stupid because we insist on being super smart. Jesus clearly, simply, and literally told his apostles that he would be arrested and killed and rise from death three days later, and they did not understand it. Why not? It could not have been any clearer: because they insisted on interpreting it in some symbolic, mystical, esoteric, or allegorical way. Why? Why were they looking for some hidden meaning when the meaning was right out there in front of them? Because they could not believe the obvious, literal meaning of it. This is a good example of how faith often comes first and leads reason, leads the mind, rather than vice versa."

"One of the 20th century's profoundest theologians, Hans Urs von Balthasar, was once asked what he thought he would ask St. John the Evangelist, if he met him in heaven, and what John's answer would be. Balthasar answered something like this: "Well, I would probably be stupid enough to ask him what was the significance of the number 153 in the last chapter of his Gospel. When he met Jesus after his resurrection on the shore, after he had been fishing all night and caught nothing, Jesus told him to cast his nets on the other side of the boat. He caught so many fish that they almost sank the boat, and when he landed and counted the fish, there were 153 of them. I am embarrassed to say that I would probably ask him why he wrote that number, and he would probably give me this profound answer: Because they were 153 of them."..."

... "Good teachers usually mean exactly what they say, and their students are often surprised at that. That is why Jesus often has to add the rabbinic formula "Don't nuance this; don't allegorize it; don't dance clever little dances around the strait, clear, plain, and obvious meaning of it. I say exactly what I mean, and I mean exactly what I say."

"There are often many layers of meaning in Jesus profound sayings, but they always add to the 1st and clearest and obvious meaning; they never subtract from it or offer an alternative to it, a way to avoid it."...

- ... "Jesus is much more often misunderstood. By sophisticated theologians than by simple Saints like Mother Teresa of Kolkata, who rarely use words of more than one syllable, but who never lost an argument. Her sayings, like Jesus, always cut through the baloney. For instance, "How can there be too many children? That is like saying there are too many flowers."..."
- ... "There is a line in an old hymn that says, "If our love were but simpler, we should take Him at his word." In addition, if we did that, what would happen? Read the Gospels again with that in mind and find out. Spoiler alert: I'll give you one prediction If you do that, if you believe everything Jesus says, your life will never be the same again."
