With such a mentality, we are but one-step removed from prejudice and from regarding people who differ from our way of thinking as 'not one of us'. We all share, we all belong and we are all sent out to partake in the saving work of Jesus. The question facing us is how eager are we to welcome outsiders into our midst and accept them as one of
