Are you the king of the Jews?

"In today's Gospel, it is ironic that it is Pontius Pilate who asks Jesus, "Are you the King of the Jews?" Jesus does not look like a king. He has just been tortured, scourged, and crowned with thorns, not with gold, and Pilate is about to sentence him to be crucified. And Jesus answers Pilate's question by affirming that his kingdom is not of this world. He is a greater king, not a lessor one, than Caesar, Lord of the world. He is the king of all earthly rulers including Pilate.

Jesus gave a strange answer to Pilate's question. Pilate asked, "Then you are a king?" And Jesus answered, "You say I am a king." but Pilate did not say that Jesus was a king; Pilate asked Jesus whether he was a king. What's going on here? When Pilate had Jesus crucified, he had his sign made to go on the cross that said, "Jesus the Nazarene, the King of the Jews." ... Why did Pilate say that? Because Pilate knew, that Jesus really was a king. Pilate was not ignorant.... He may have not known that Jesus was divine, but he did know that Jesus was innocent, yet he sinned against the truth he knew, against his own conscience. That's why Jesus said to Pilate, "You say I am a king. [In other words, your own conscience tells you that I am a true king, a spiritual king.] For this I was born, and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth. Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice". Pilate deliberately sinned against the truth that he knew. He sneeringly and scornfully said, "What is truth?". In other words, "truth be damned." He did not merely condemn Christ; He condemned truth, and that is a mortal sin. It kills the soul. If not repented of, it prevents you from going to heaven. Whenever we ask God "Who are you?" God replies, "Who are vou?" We have to answer that question every time we make a choice between good and evil, or between truth. and falsehood, between light and darkness, between the true God and false gods, idols. All sins are idolatries. That is our life task, because God is real, and there is only one God, and only God is God, and nothing else is God, and God is the king of all creation, the king of the universe, and the king of every human person, and of every human life.

If you really believe that and practice that in our lives, then the Kingdom of God will come, and God's will will be done on earth by us as it is in heaven by the angels. That is the ultimate meaning of our lives: to be honest, unlike Pilate; to love and seek and acknowledge and live the truth; to be sane, to live in reality, to live in the real world, to live out the ultimate fact that Jesus Christ is Lord."

And Jesus Christ is God; Jesus Christ is Lord. That is the first and shortest of all Christian creeds. We find it stated


