

#### We Have No Wine

After celebrating Christmas for the past 20 days, we now return to Ordinary Time. It should be noted that many Catholics continue to celebrate Christmas until February 2<sup>nd</sup>, the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, as was the case before the Second Vatican Council, for a total of 40 days echoing the 40 days of Lent so if you still have your Christmas decorations up like me it's ok.

With all that has happened over the past few weeks now is a good time to reflect back on some of the gifts received. One gift received that stands out for me occurred on December 22<sup>nd</sup> when the parish began Christmas decorations. I entered the hall with my son at the established time and was surprised we were the only two, as usually the decorating crew is quite large. I was wondering to myself how the two of us would manage to get everything done but I didn't panic as many servings of humble pie over the years have taught me not to despair in such situations.

This year was no different and after about five minutes, God started providing. First, our parish secretary entered the hall and a few minutes later, some choir members appeared. Then out of the blue more parishioners came and asked if we needed help. I asked them how they knew we were decorating, and they said they didn't but as they drove by the church something inspired them to go inside and see if help was needed. I was in awe. As the afternoon continued, more and more people arrived and all I could do was smile and whisper to God: "You are so good." The next day even more volunteers continued the decorating.

We witness something similar happening in our Gospel this weekend as we encounter Jesus' first miracle at the Wedding Feast at Cana. Our Blessed Mother was concerned the wedding couple would run out of wine just as I was concerned, we would run out of energy to get the decorating done. Mary trusted her Son would provide and Jesus certainly does, providing 180 litres of choice wine, far exceeding all expectations, just as my expectations were far exceeded by the number of volunteers. And what joy the servants at the wedding feast must have had manifesting Jesus' first miracle just as the decorating team experienced great joy manifesting this modern-day miracle.

In Cana, Jesus' generosity allowed for the celebration to continue with elevated spirits just as the decorations allowed our Christmas' celebrations to continue with elevated spirits. In future, I hope to draw on this experience and the experience of Cana. When I am struggling, and doubts and anxiety start bubbling up I hope to remember to bring my concerns to Our Blessed Mother and wholeheartedly trust in the last words we hear from her in the Bible: "Do whatever he tells you". Amen.




