



Today's gospel story is about salvation, of sin committed and sin forgiven. Nowhere is the saving power of God more evident than in the forgiveness of sin. He reaches out to hearts in ways beyond explaining. God does not look at our faults or failings but expresses his belief in our inner goodness. We need to acknowledge our sins if we are to be forgiven. Jesus offers all who come to him the opportunity to turn away from wrongdoing, to put the past behind, to be forgiven and embark upon a new life. All we have to do is open our hearts to receive his grace.

As our Lenten season draws to an end, we should give added thought to our sins by taking a close look at our lives in order to determine the direction we are taking. Where have we come from & where are we going? Ours is a journey into the God who is perfect love, perfect understanding and perfect forgiveness. Like the woman in the gospel, we may have to make certain adjustments if we are to get to know the Lord who looks beyond our present situation and sees a person in need of his forgiveness, love and grace.


