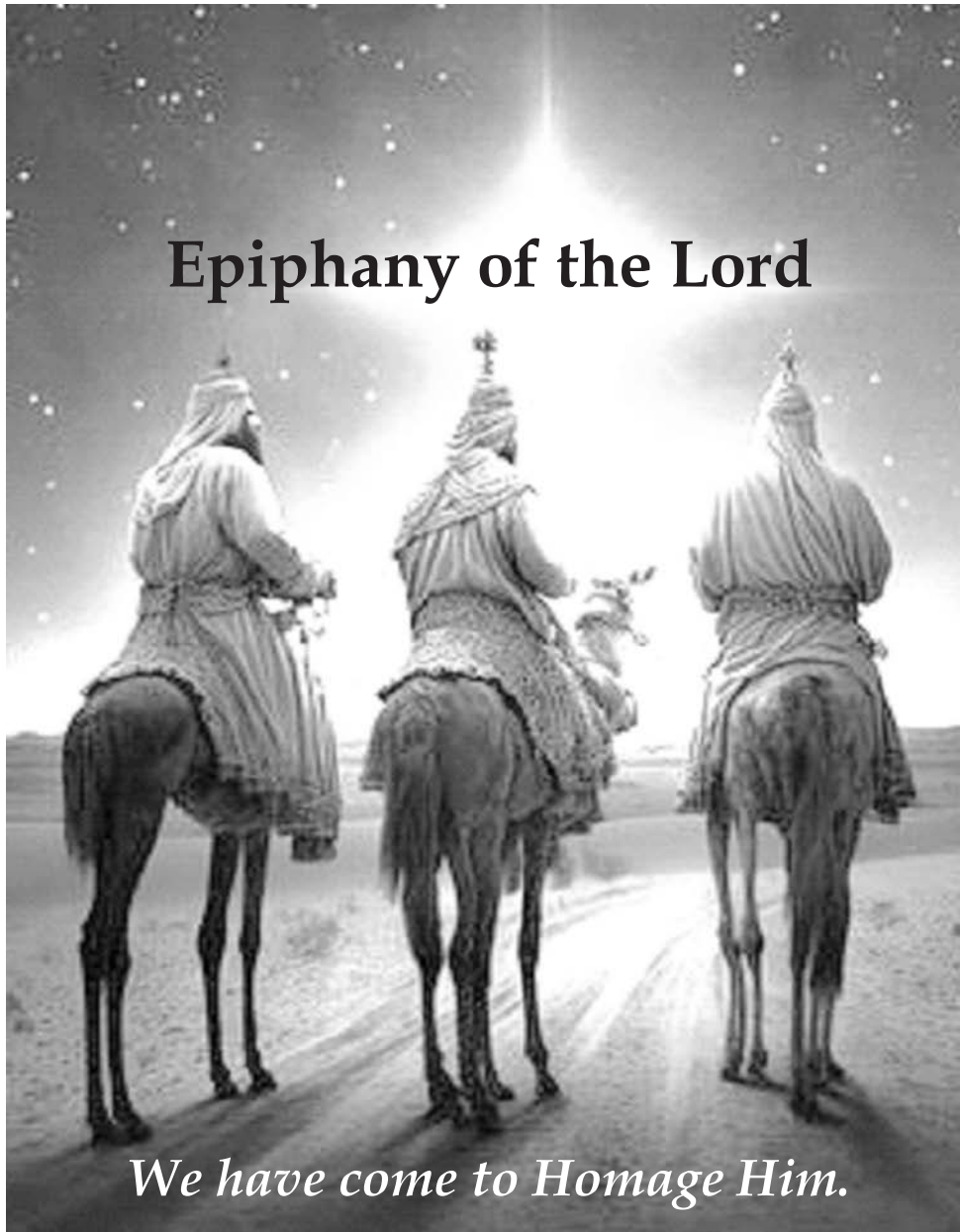

What Did the Magi See?

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany. The word epiphany means to manifest or reveal. The three primary epiphanies in the bible are the Epiphany to the Magi, the Baptism of our Lord and the Wedding Feast at Cana. At each of these primary manifestations, something is being communicated or revealed to the world about the identity of Jesus.

At the Baptism of our Lord, and the wedding Feast at Cana, it is clear how the identity of Jesus is revealed. With the Baptism of our Lord, God's voice announces to John his Son's identity saying: "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased," and at the wedding feast at Cana, Jesus identity is made visible by his turning water into wine. But with the Magi the revelation of Jesus' identity isn't so clear.

The Magi were guided by the miraculous behavior of the star but what did these Gentiles witness in the Holy Family that assured them of Jesus' divine identity? What did they see in this simple Jewish family living in Bethlehem so long ago that assured them that divinity was present?

As I continued to reflect, I realized that the answer was right under my nose. I only needed to observe my own family buzzing around me to see that the Epiphany surrounded me. Every fight, every cuddle, every tear, every laugh, every kiss pointed to a celestial Mystery beyond us. The key was looking up with the eyes of faith to witness God at work in everything and treasure the Spirit's movements. We need only look to Herod in the story to see how easily we can be blind and hardened to God at work.

Within each person and within ourselves we encounter an epiphany of God's grace just waiting to be unwrapped and discovered. A gift to be opened revealing the nature of God our creator. How 'Magi'cal life becomes when we truly look at everything we encounter as an epiphany. Suddenly ordering a coffee at Tim Horton's or changing a baby's diaper becomes a transcendental experience, an encounter with the divine.

I think this is what the Magi encountered when they looked in upon the Holy Family. They saw a family that treasured every moment, every encounter with one another. A family so in love and in touch with God that the love radiated throughout their entire house, their village, their country and the world. A palpable love that the Magi had been longing for their entire lives that they had to share with the world.

A love I feel so blessed to encounter each Sunday here at St. Luke's as we relive the Epiphany and Jesus is born again on the altar. Let us go forth this day, and share the Light that shines within each of us and reveal God to all we encounter. Let us live God's eternal epiphany. John Humphries.

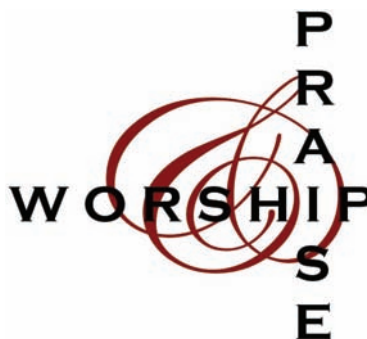
York Catholic District School Board Kindergarten Registration for the 2026-27 school year begins January 5, 2026

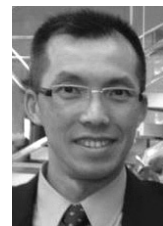
