The Mystery of Life?

One lovely summer's day around noon, there was a deep stillness over all the forest. The birds had tucked their heads under their wings, and everything was at rest. Then a bullfinch popped his head up and asked, "What is life? Everyone was struck by this profound question. A rose was just emerging from her bud, and was opening up one shy petal after another, rejoicing in the newly discovered sunlight. 'Life is a Becoming,' she said. The butterfly was less philosophical. He flew blithely from one flower to another, snacking everywhere on the delicious nectar. 'Life is pure pleasure and sunshine,' he announced. 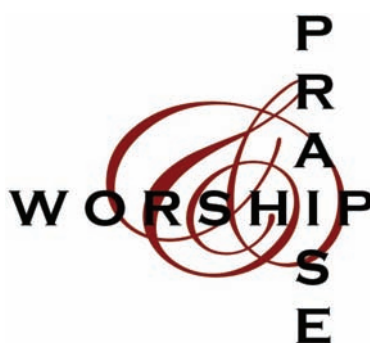

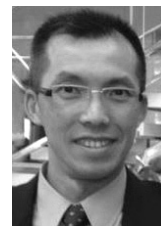

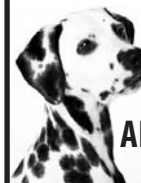
