The message of Jesus never ceases to amaze us. The real standard is whether our motives are sincere. We might fool some with a good and charitable act, but never God or our conscience.

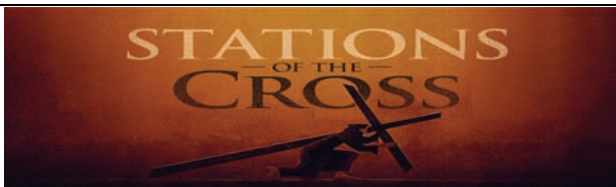

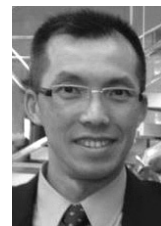
